As we convene the 52nd Annual NBNA Institute and Conference, we continue to celebrate our beginnings and amplify the importance of our very first conference held in Cleveland, Ohio in September of 1972.

Fifty-two years later, black nurses remain strong and are key leaders in reducing disparities and advancing health equity through their innovations in nursing practice, education, research, policy advocacy, and entrepreneurship. 
